Mike Fey is the co-founder and CEO of Island, a company that developed the first enterprise browser, aiming to provide businesses with enhanced security, visibility, and control over their users, apps, and data. His extensive background spans cybersecurity, enterprise software, and cloud technology.

Before starting Island, Mike served in high-profile leadership roles, including as CEO of D2iQ (formerly Mesosphere), and as president and COO at both Symantec and Blue Coat. While at Blue Coat, he played a key role in growing the company, leading to its acquisition by Symantec for \$4.7 billion in 2016. Mike has also been the executive vice president and general manager of enterprise products at McAfee and CTO of Intel Security.

Mike holds a degree in Engineering Physics and Mathematics from Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University and is also an author, having co-written *Security Battleground: An Executive Field Manual*, which provides cybersecurity insights for executives without a technical background.

Mike's leadership at Island reflects his vision of creating a secure-by-design work environment, where browsers are built for enterprise needs rather than consumer use.
