John Redgrave is an expert on AI, digital safety, and start-ups. He is a co-founder and general partner at DTX Ventures, an early-stage venture fund in Dallas that invests in companies protecting American sovereignty, and an active startup advisor.

He most recently served as Vice President of Trust & Safety at Discord. John joined the company from Sentropy (acquired by Discord), an internet security company that built machine learning products to detect and fight online abuse, where he served as CEO & Co-Founder.

Before founding Sentropy, John was COO of Lattice Data (acquired by Apple), an Al company focused on rapid knowledge construction to fuel the next generation of Al applications. Before Lattice, he served as Head of Strategy and Operations at Palantir Technologies, where he was one of the first 100 employees.

Additionally, John has been an early-stage investor in start-ups for over a decade through Redgrave Capital, with over 40 investments, numerous exits, and multiple unicorns in his portfolio.

John obtained his MBA from Stanford's Graduate School of Business and his bachelor's degree with honors from Brown University.
