Anurag Jain is a Dallas-based entrepreneur, investor, and philanthropist. He is the founder of Access Healthcare, which he built into one of the nation's largest revenue cycle management companies before its 2024 combination with New Mountain Capital–backed firms SmarterDX and Thoughtful.ai to form Smarter Technologies, a \$6 billion healthcare services platform where Jain now serves on the board.

He is also the Managing Partner of Perot Jain, a venture capital firm he co-founded with Ross Perot Jr. that has invested in over 50 disruptive companies across Al, robotics, and other breakthrough technologies. A passionate cricket fan, Jain is the majority owner of the Texas Super Kings, Dallas's Major League Cricket team.

Committed to civic leadership, Jain has served on the boards of the Dallas Regional Chamber, the US India Chamber of Commerce, and as Chairman-Emeritus of the North Texas Food Bank. In 2020, he co-founded Get Shift Done, which delivered 60 million meals and paid \$15 million in wages to displaced service workers during the COVID-19 crisis, earning recognition as Fast Company's Most Innovative Not-For-Profit Organization. He holds an MBA from the University of Michigan and a B.E. in Electrical and Electronics Engineering from BITS Pilani, India.
